

WHAT MAKES EUROPEAN BASKETBALL EUROPEAN?

Research Approach and Full Source Register

A. Research Purpose

This research asks how the identity of European basketball is understood by people who have experienced and shaped the modern game. Rather than beginning with a predetermined definition, the project treats public basketball discourse itself as the dataset and asks which institutions, practices, values and relationships repeatedly appear as meaningful, distinctive and worth carrying forward.

The broader purpose is to distinguish historical conventions from the mechanisms through which European basketball reproduces knowledge, belonging, competitive meaning and development. The project therefore asks not only what European basketball has looked like, but what enables it to remain culturally recognizable while continuing to change.

B. Methodology

The full research design covers 75 prominent figures across different generations, countries and professional roles. Individuals were selected purposively for their relevance to European basketball since approximately the 1990s, their ability to reflect beyond their own career, comparative or cross-system experience, availability of substantive public material and the objective of covering different basketball cultures and stakeholder perspectives.

The evidence base consists primarily of long-form interviews, podcasts, speeches, documentaries, federation and club material, historical retrospectives and specialist basketball media. Preference is given to direct first-person material and authoritative institutional sources. Themes are not treated as European merely because they appear strongly in one country. Replication across basketball geographies and roles is central to the analysis.

C. Analytical Framework

The coding framework separates four layers: cultural and institutional artifacts, basketball practices, cultural DNA and the relationship with change. Recurring categories include the club, coach, youth and academy, national team, domestic and European competition, supporters, rivalry, basketball place, teaching, player development, meaningful responsibility, team play, basketball knowledge, belonging, continuity, sporting merit, competitive consequence, pluralism, stewardship, emotional intensity, globalization and adaptation without imitation.

D. Current Reference Population

The appendix covers all 75 selected individuals and consolidates the retained source register in one unified format. Only sources with a verified direct URL are included in the register.

E. Source Register by Individual

This register consolidates the retained research source base across all 75 cases. Each source is presented as a numbered, concise description followed by a clickable verified source URL.
